pay to the BSNL an amount not exceeding against any loss or damage caused to or				
suffered or would be caused to or suffered by BSNL by reason of any breach by the said Bidder(s) of any of the

2. We (name of the bank) _______ do hereby undertake to pay the amounts due and payable under this guarantee without any demur, merely on a demand from the BSNL by reason of breach by the said bidder(s)' of any of the terms or conditions contained in the said Agreement or by reason of the bidders(s)' failure to perform the said Agreement. Any such demand made on the bank shall be conclusive as regards the amount due and payable by the Bank under this guarantee where the decision of BSNL in these counts shall be final and binding on the bank. We undertake to pay to the BSNL any money so demanded notwithstanding any dispute or disputes raised by the bidder(s)/supplier(s) in any suit or proceeding pending before any court or tribunal relating thereto our liability under this present being absolute and unequivocal. The payment so made by us under this bond shall be valid discharge of our liability for payment there under and the bidder(s)/supplier(s) shall have no claim against us for making such payment.

We (name of the bank)_______ further agree with the BSNL that the BSNL shall have the fullest liberty without our consent and without affecting in any manner our obligations hereunder to vary any of the terms and conditions of the said Agreement or to extend time of performance by the said bidder(s) from time to time or to postpone for any time or from time to time any of the powers exercisable by the BSNL against the said Bidder(s) and to forbear or enforce any of the terms and conditions relating to the said agreement and we shall not be relieved from our liability by reason of any such variation, or extension being granted to the said Bidder(s) or for any forbearance, act or omission on the part of the BSNL or any indulgence by the BSNL to the said Bidder(s) or by any such matter or thing whatsoever which under the law relating to sureties would, but for this provision, have effect of so relieving us.

6. This guarantee will not be discharged due to the change in the constitution of the Bank or the Bidder(s)/supplier(s).
